Privacy Policy

This website is operated by BMS Risk Solutions Pty Ltd ("us, we, our") - ABN 45 161 187 980 and AFSL 461594. We are committed to protecting and respecting your privacy in relation to information that we may collect while operating the website, and are bound by the Privacy Act 1988 (Cth) and the Australian Privacy Principles (the "**Privacy Laws**"). This policy sets out the basis on which we will process any personal information which we collect from you, or which you provide to us.

PERSONAL INFORMATION THAT WE MAY COLLECT FROM YOU

We collect non-personally-identifying information relating to your use of the website to enable us to better understand how visitors use the website. Except for those of our employees, contractors and members of our group mentioned above, we disclose personal information only when required to do so by law, or when we believe in good faith that disclosure is reasonably necessary to protect our property or rights or those of any third parties or members of the public.

We will disclose personal information where required to do so by the Privacy Laws.

SECURITY

We maintain appropriate security standards and procedures with a view to preventing unauthorised access, use, alteration or destruction of potentially non-personally-identifying and personally-identifying information. We use leading technologies such as (but not limited to) data encryption, fire walls and server authentication to protect the security of your personally-identifying information.

ACCESS TO YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION

You may access the personal information we hold about you and to update and/or correct it, subject to certain exceptions. If you wish to access your personal information, please contact us in writing.

We will not charge any fee for your access request, but may charge an administrative fee for providing a copy of your personal information.

In order to protect your personal information we may require identification from you before releasing the requested information.

COOKIES
