Summary of Position:

You will collaborate closely with various business stakeholders to understand their needs, analyse data, and develop compelling visualizations that effectively communicate key insights and trends.

- Provide training and guidance on data visualisation and data management practices to employees and stakeholders.
- Collect, clean, and analyse large datasets from diverse sources.

- Develop and implement data-driven solutions to address business problems and meet stakeholder needs.
- Rapidly prototype solutions using visualisation tools to validate concepts and minimise development time.
